↳ Verse 21 refers to a story in judges

Verses 25-27

↳ We are not sure if Bathsheba knew her husband was home or if they ever saw each other.

↳ Bathsheba lamented over the death of her husband. She mourned him.

↳ She then married David & bore him a son.

↳ "The Lord considered what David had done to be evil"

↳ God is not mentioned very much in the chapter, which can show David's relationship w/ God at this moment.

↳ What story does this story parallel?

* David & Uriah / Judas

↳ What do we learn about David's sin?

* Our actions have consequences

* He acted out of heightened emotion.
